Student Retention Rates

The Department of Education requires our reporting of student retention rates during the spring reporting cycle each year. The data reported is based upon our first-time, full-time new undergraduate students which typically represents less than 5% of our overall student enrollment. This current year's report reflected the rates of the cohort from the fall of 2011 that returned in the fall of 2012.

The summary retention rates are shown below.
