## **Institute for Lay Ministry**

The Institute for Lay Ministry offers theology courses and formational experiences designed with flexibility and may be taken *ala carte* according to personal interest, or as part of deeper ministerial discernment and preparation. Courses are not for college credit and are open to all Catholics who seek to grow in their faith. In addition, programming is perfect for catechetical leaders, catechists, parish and schools leaders, liturgists/musicians ministers, members of pastoral teams, parish councils and those engaged in societal ministries. No prior education is required to enroll in Institute for Lay Ministry courses.

'Single course only' registration is available and welcomed. Those who complete **all** 120 hours of theology (12 core courses) and 40 hours of formation offered during the **Institute for Lay Ministry's** two-year cycle will be candidates to receive a Saint Clare Center *Certificate in Lay Ministries*. Requirements for *Certificate* candidates include completing a comprehensive portfolio assessment, an interview with Saint Clare Center staff, and a pastoral recommendation.
