

Stritch Unstopped: Holiday Edition

Cardinal Stritch University students, faculty and staff are to be commended for their efforts to keep the campus safe and healthy. As the number of positive COVID-19 cases continues to increase in the greater Milwaukee area, across Wisconsin, our nation, and the world we must re-commit ourselves to doing everything we can to create and maintain a safe and healthy environment for members of the Stritch community.

As announced earlier this year, all courses will transition entirely to virtual academic delivery as of Monday, November 23. University facilities will remain open during this time. Final exams for traditional undergraduate courses will take place online from December 5-11.

Students and employees should continue to follow the **Stritch Unstopped** protocols that include self-monitoring, reporting close contact with individuals who are COVID-19 positive to Student Health Services (students) or their supervisor (employees), and practicing preventative measures to protect their health and well-being and the health and well-being of others.

Recognizing that limiting the number of people on campus enhances the health and safety of the community, Stritch will continue the level of reduced on-campus staffing used during the fall semester through January 2021. Spring staffing levels are still being determined at this time, but it is expected that employees continue to follow the University's Telecommuting policy during this period. Supervisors will work with members of their respective staffs to develop appropriate staffing plans and revise the Telecommuting status of employees as needed with the approval of the respective Vice President.

All University guests will still be required to check-in and register at the Bonaventure Hall Welcome Desk and check-out at the same location before leaving campus. Guests are required to wear face masks/coverings and have a Guest badge visible at all times for the duration of their stay on campus.
