## ARTICULATION AGREEMENT TRANSFER SUMMARY WCTC AAS Criminal Justice—Law Enforcement to BS Criminal Justice

Students earning an AAS in Criminal Justice—Law Enforcement from Waukesha County Technical College as of May 2015 may transfer 70 credits toward a BS in Criminal Justice at Cardinal Stritch University. The following chart outlines a possible transfer scenario, how those credits apply to the BS degree, and which requirements remain to complete at Stritch. To maximize credit transfer, one or more substitutions may be identified. Transfer results may differ based on individual students' transcripts.
