## ARTICULATION AGREEMENT TRANSFER SUMMARY

### MATC AA Liberal Arts: Ed Found to BA Secondary Ed: Early Adol.- Adol./Early Childhood-Adol.

Students earning an AA Educational Foundations degree from MATC as of May 2015 may transfer up to 64 credits toward a BA in Secondary Education for Early Adolescence to Adolescence or Early Childhood to Adolescence certification at Cardinal Stritch University. The following chart outlines a possible transfer scenario, how those credits apply to the BA degree, and which requirements remain to complete at Stritch. Transfer results may differ based on individual students' transcripts.
