To recognize students for their commitment to cultural diversity and an inclusive society

Faculty, staff and students are invited to nominate a student for the Diversity and Inclusion award which is designed to recognize and encourage a commitment to intercultural communication, cooperation and efforts toward building an inclusive society and campus community. This award is open to students of all degree levels. Students are welcome to nominate themselves or other students for this award.

The award recipient is selected by the Student Affairs Committee and is a student whose nomination and record while enrolled clearly show:

- Exemplary personal leadership to the Stritch community, one's profession, or the greater community in the area of diversity and inclusion;
- Demonstrated personal support and appreciation of diversity and inclusiveness in their personal life;
- Enrolled at Stritch for a minimum of one year with a record of academic achievement.

A written statement that addresses the following (to the extent known by you, nominees may be contacted if further information is required):

1. Please describe in detail how the nominee provides leadership to the Stritch community, one's profession, and/or the greater community in the area of diversity and inclusion.
2. Please describe how the nominee's personal life exhibits a commitment to diversity and inclusion.
