## ARTICULATION AGREEMENT TRANSFER SUMMARY MATC AAS Baking & Pastry Arts to BS Hospitality Management

Students earning an AAS in Baking & Pastry Arts from MATC as of May 2015 may transfer up to 69 credits toward a BS in Hospitality Mgt at Cardinal Stritch University, with the addition of 14 credits as specified in the articulation agreement between the two schools. The following chart outlines a possible transfer scenario, how those credits apply to the BS degree, and which requirements remain to complete at Stritch. To maximize credit transfer, some substitutions may be identified. Transfer results may differ based on individual students' transcripts.
