ARTICULATION AGREEMENT TRANSFER SUMMARY

AAS Instructional Assistant to BS Elementary Education, Early Childhood-Middle Childhood

Students earning an Instructional Assistant AAS degree from a WI Technical College System school as of May 2014 may transfer up to 49 credits toward a BS in Elementary Ed for Early-Middle Childhood certification at Cardinal Stritch University. The following chart outlines a possible transfer scenario, how those credits apply to the BS degree, and which requirements remain to complete at Stritch. To maximize credit transfer, some substitutions have been identified. Transfer results may differ based on individual students' transcripts.
