ARTICULATION AGREEMENT TRANSFER SUMMARY WTCS AAS Registered Nursing to RN to BSN program

Students earning a Registered Nursing AAS degree from a Wisconsin Technical College System school as of May 2006 may transfer 70 credits toward the RN to BSN program at Cardinal Stritch University. The following chart outlines a possible transfer scenario, how those credits will apply to the BS degree, and which requirements remain to complete at Stritch. Transfer results may differ based on individual students' transcripts.
